## Students Feedback for AY 2022-23

## Analysis of students' feedback for Chemistry and Biochemistry courses

Students feedback for Chemistry and Biochemistry courses of the Academic year 2022-23 as received from Goa University Directorate of Internal Quality Assurance was shared among all the faculty members of School council. This students' feedback was scrutinised and analysed by the members during the School Council meeting and observed that there were not many courses with overall >10% unsatisfactory remarks and some unsatisfactory remarks were noted particularly for Part-II syllabus content of the courses and IT facilities available to the students.

## Action taken report

To address the concerns regarding syllabus content for Part-II courses, revision of syllabus was undertaken as per NEP framework effective for Part-I from 2022-23 and for Part-II from 2023-24.

IT facilities are under upgradation and SCS has recently purchased sufficient PCs to facilitate dissertation literature review for students. 25 PCs were donated by Syngenta Biosciences Pvt. Ltd., Corlim out of which 16 PCs are already installed in SCS Internet room and 9 PCs will be installed in the committee room exclusively for students. Purchase order is forwarded for 25 thin clients base PC set ups to be installed in Computational Chemistry Laboratory and the purchase process for 10 PCs for computational chemistry dissertations students is ongoing.
