The liabilities of the Government in the form of accommodation (hotels), vehicles, tours, boats and other properties were transferred to Goa Tourism Development Corporation Ltd to run and to manage the same with a view to promoting, developing in the state and to carry out business and to manage the welfare of the employees transferred along with the assets of the Government. Goa Tourism Development Corporation. Ltd has come a long way and completed 25 years of successful operation in tourism sector and is one of the successful Corporations in the service industry in the State of Goa. The company is governed by the Board of Directors appointed by the Government. The Board of Directors consists of 12 members. The shareholders consist of 7 members, all of whom are Government nominees. All the shares are held by the Governor of Goa, except 7 shares which are held by its nominees. Department of Tourism

The Tourist Information Centres/Counters are located within the State. The Zonal Officers are primarily responsible for monitoring the registration of tourist trade under the Tourist Trade Act, 1982. The Administrative head

of the Department is Shri. Ravi Dhawan, IAS, Secretary Tourism. The Department has zonal office in North Goa at Headquarters, Panaji and in South Goa at Margao. The Current Director of Tourism is Shri Nikhil Dessai, IAS. The Zonal Officers are primarily responsible for monitoring the Registration of Tourist Trade under the Tourist Trade Act, 1982.

Activities of the Department:

- Policy Formulation.
- Development of Infrastructure.
- The Goa Tourist Places (Protection & Maintenance) Act, 2001.
- The Goa Land (Prohibition of Construction) Act, 1995.
- Administration of Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act.

It is mandatory for all Hotels, Travel Agents, Tour Operators, Tourist Guides, Tourist Taxi Operators and Dealers of notified articles and other persons engaged in tourist activities to register themselves under the Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act. Registration is to be annually renewed.

Under the Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act, Dy. Director (North) & Dy. Director (South) is the Prescribed Authority to issue certificate of registration.

Training schedule At GTDC Residencies

- I was sent to 7 residencies of GTDC which included Panjim, Calangute, Colva, Margao, Vasco, Miramar and Mapusa. I was made to carry out various tasks at the reception.(Front Desk)
- At the reception, I handled calls from guest rooms, took guest entries at the time of check ins, obtained guest ID's and updated it on the software (Renzo), in the system and checked out guests.
