About the place - The history of Bondla and its surroundings can be traced back to the Sixth Century AD. based on several idols of archaeological significance excavated from this region. Bondla Zoo is located at the trijunction of Dharbandora-Sattari-Ponda taluka and is surrounded by six villages . The Bondla zoo is located at an elevation of 170 m above sea level within the Bondla Wildlife Sanctuary. The terrain is mostly hilly and undulating with elevation ranging from 150 m to 242 m above sea level. Several perennial and seasonal streams that drain into the Ragada river and the area within Bondla WLS and Zoo forms a very important water catchment region for the Ragda river in the east and Mhadei river in the north. The main focus of our trip would be watching herpetofauna. The walk offers a fantastic opportunity to explore the forest which is extremely rich in herpetofauna, wildflowers and birds. Majorly snakes, frogs and geckos.

#### TOURIST INFORMATION CENTER

The Tourist Information Centres/Counters are located within the State. The Zonal Officers are primarily responsible for monitoring the registration of tourist trade under the Tourist Trade Act, 1982. The Administrative head of the Department is Shri. Ravi Dhawan, IAS, Secretary Tourism. The Department has zonal office in North Goa at Headquarters, Panaji and in South Goa at Margao. The Current Director of Tourism is Shri Nikhil Dessai, IAS. The Zonal Officers are primarily responsible for monitoring the Registration of Tourist Trade under the Tourist Trade Act, 1982.

Activities of the Department :-

Policy Formulation. Development of Infrastructure. The Goa Tourist Places (Protection & Maintenance) Act, 2001. The Goa Land (Prohibition of Construction) Act, 1995. Administration of Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act.

It is mandatory for all Hotels, Travel Agents, Tour Operators, Tourist Guides, Tourist Taxi Operators and Dealers of notified articles and other persons engaged in tourist activities to register themselves under the Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act. Registration is to be annually renewed.

Under the Goa Registration of Tourist Trade Act, Dy. Director (North) & Dy. Director (South) is the Prescribed Authority to issue certificate of registration.

In our internship each intern was placed in every departments and residencies expect for engineering and accounts. For 2 weeks each where we had observed and help the employees.

## Hotel Establishment Department (H.E)

This department looks after the investments i.e., building of shops, residencies

etc. Thy also handle the legal matters of GTDC.

They collect the rent from all the shops and even money from property which are given on lease.

This department takes decision on retendering.

If any residency wants to do some changes in their property, then have to ask the permission of this department.

In this section they held all the bills pertaining to the basic requirement of the hotel such as the electricity bill, linen, furniture, toiletries and imprest funds etc.

Here bills are checked and then a report is made which is then forwarded to the Dy DM of hotel(H.k) ad GMF.

There are many quotations from different buyers but gradually the deal is always given to the buyer with the least amount this is then sent to the tender committee.

In this section most of the work is on the properties of GTDC i.e. the shops, restaurants, lands, etc.

Shops and restaurants are leased out for shops its 9 years and restaurants 21 years after which they are retendered.

Every three years there is an increase in rents of

shops 25% ,Restaurants 7% ,Properties 7% .

Duties performed in Hotel Establishment Section

- To look after properties given on lease.
- To look after GTDC hotels and cruises.
- To check requirements of hotel eg. Housekeeping items (bed, linen etc.)
- To maintain register of complaint/problems related to rooms of all GTDC hotels (eg breakdown/non working of a/c or any other problems related to rooms)
- Make sure to meet all requirements of GTDC hotels/ solving problems related to GTDC hotel.
- Visiting the GTDC hotels.

## **ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT**

This department is concerned with employees' transfers or recruitment of new employees in GTDC.

One of most important function of this department is recruitment of new employees.

Any purchases in GTDC is looked by this department itself i.e. outward and inward (letters, orders, circulars are send or come to the corporation)

This department also look for the leaves like casual leaves, earned leaves, sick leave, etc.

They also handle the monthly attendance of the employee

#### **Duties performed in Administration Section**

- Maintaining registers for record of outward letters.
- Preparing letters to be sent with address, pincode, stamp.
- Different types of leave to be sanctioned (EI,CI,RH,C off)
- Maintaining registers for record of outward letters.
- Preparing letters to be sent with address ,pincode, stamps.
- Different types of leave to be sanctioned (El, Cl,RH,C.off)

## **TRAVEL SECTION**

Planning and selling transportations, accommodations, insurance and other travel services. Cooperating with clients to determine their needs and advising them appropriate destination, modes of transportations, travel dates, costs and accommodations.

## **Duties performed**

- Look after the booking of taxes/ buses in all the government department and also private parties, also arrange pickup/drop and sight-seeing, tours, taxis for the package.
- Attending phone calls, booking if required.
- Cancellation online/offline and send emails, speed post letters.
- Also put the files of the restaurants of the breakfast coupons.
- Expedia and clear trip bookings and maintenance of records and put their commission.
- Attending walk in guest, documentation of records, and maintenance of registers.
- Reply to emails, Preponement/postponement of bookings and also typing work.
- Maintain Axis, HDFC statement files.
- Keep record of daily occupancy and CEST of offline north and south Goa tours inventory of al residency and releasing room as per cut off period. All the receipt should be generated and duly signed.
- Travel Guru, booking.com, make my trip, HOHO bookings and issue of receipts, commission statement and documentation of record and maintain registers.

## **Marketing Section**

- Participating at the Trade and Tourism Events in India and Abroad
- Hosting events Food, Carnival, Shigmo etc.
- Sponsorship for the Events
- Advertisement on Newspapers, Magazine, TV, Social Media, Hoardings, Malls etc.

Duties and responsibilities of Marketing Staff

- Meeting visitors as and when they come to office
- Preparing Agendas and Minutes of SLMPC, TESC, BOD
- Ensuring that the approved proposals of SLMPC are placed in a separate file with all the relevant details /approvals and also ensure that the deliverables promised and met.
- Processing of bills GTDC property Tenders, New Tourism Services Tenders, Advertisement
- Arrangement of Press conferences, Meetings, FAM Trips, etc. with the help of PR Team.
- Preparation of the draft Tender Terms and Conditions related to various GTDC properties, New Tourism Services, Events
- Assisting Top Management in various Government Tenders
- Ensuring that all Government /Administrative approval are obtained before starting any project/service.

#### **Account Section**

The accounting department is responsible for recording and reporting the cash flows, both in and out, of a company. There are five basic roles or functions within the department:

- Accounts receivable
- Accounts payable
- Payroll
- Financial controls
- Financial reporting

Each of these functions will be explored throughout this lesson. Because financial controls are an important part of every area of the accounting department, these will be mentioned along with each function

## Duties and responsibilities

- Preparation of Journal entries, Bank Reconciliation statement
- Entry of Receipts & Payment vouchers into computer and print
- Verification of Monthly report of trial balance ,cash book, Journal book, and capital accounts to be tallied.
- Maintenance of books of accounts & supervision of Receipt & Payment Voucher files
- Other related files to be processed.

#### **Engineering section**

Engineering department of a hotel has great importance in as much as it provides utility services like electricity, steam, hot water, air-conditioning and refrigeration, maintain engineering and services of various other equipment. Provisions of proper services and proper maintenance affairs in hotels have great impact on the attitude of the guest. Therefore, hotel engineering department has big responsibility in satisfying guest demand and be instrumental in maintaining the profit level of hotels up to reasonable standard

Duties and responsibilities

- Engineering department looks after maintain work in residency
- Preparing Estimates e-tenders and processing for approvals
- Recording of buildings
- Coordinating with fire department for obtaining NOC
- Maintains of sewage treatment plant
- Making emergency arrangements for coordination of demolition squad
- Attending the field survey for demarcation of properties
