Hepatitis (A, B, C, D, E); HIV; Orthomyxoviruses: Influenza. Paramyxoviruses: Mumps and Measles; Arboviruses: Togavirus - Rubella; Rhabdovirus: Rabies; Corona Virus: SARS. Emerging viral agents of disease.


