D.3.14	<p>Minutes of the meeting of Board of Studies in French held on 22/02/2017</p> <p>PART – A</p> <p>i) Recommendations regarding courses of study in the subject or group of subjects at the undergraduate level.</p> <p>l) With respect to the conversion of the existing undergraduate programme into the CBCS, the BOS recommended the following.</p> <p>1) The existing BA French programme was restructured to convert it to CBCS. The BOS held on 19 February 2016 had already recommended the FYBA courses duly approved by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 26th and 29th February 2016 and courses and the syllabi for SYBA and TYBA were presented and recommended as per Appendix A1 to A12.</p> <p>THESE COURSES HAVE BEEN RECOMMENDED FOR ANY AFFILIATED COLLEGE WISHING TO INTRODUCE A PROGRAMME IN FRENCH AT THE UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL.</p> <p>II) After due discussion on the rationale of introducing a 5 year Integrated MA French Programme instead of the existing 2 years MA Programme in the Department of French and Francophone Studies in Goa University, the BOS recommended that this programme be implemented for the next academic year ie. 2017-2018 for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Presently there is only one college proposing a BA French in Goa ie. Chowgule College and from next year there will be only two affiliated colleges of Goa University offering undergraduate study in French and that too only at FYBA and SYBA. 2. There is a demand for undergraduate study in French in Goa and nearby regions and no BA programme exists in the nearby towns (eg. Kolhapur, Belgaum, Mangalore, Manipal, Karwar, Sawantwadi,...) 3. Presently a 5 year MA integrated programme in French exists only in the Jawaharlal Nehru University. 4. This would be a unique Study Programme integrating the study of French along with Portuguese language and courses in the social sciences. <p>A considerable amount of thought, discussion and research had gone into the conception and outline of this programme and the syllabus for the proposed</p>

courses were drafted after a lot of research and consultation with experts in the various subject fields of the proposed courses.

The BOS wishes to thank members of the Faculty of Goa University for their guidance in conceiving this Programme.

After due deliberation the BOS recommended the List of Courses for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year of the programme.

The features of the courses recommended for First, Second and Third year of the programme are as follows:

- 1. The list of courses recommended for the First, Second and Third year are as per Appendix B**
- 2. The syllabi for these courses are as per Appendix C1 to C-39**
- 3. Each course will be of 4 Credits with a total of 148 credits in the 3 year period in keeping with existing BA Honours Programme of Goa University.**
- 4. The programme will offer two Non Credit Language Courses in the First year for students who require additional proficiency in the language.**
- 5. The Programme will include a 4 credit project and a 4 credit internship.**
- 6. The intake into the 1st year of the 5 year integrated MA Programme would be 10.**
- 7. Students who have successfully passed Std XII may be admitted after an Entrance test and interview. Students having basic knowledge of French will be given preference.**
- 8. Students who successfully complete the first 3 years of the 5 year Integrated MA Programme may leave the course with a BA Degree in French.**
- 9. Students who are eligible for the existing 2 year MA Programme may continue to be eligible and may join the programme in the 4th year of the programme subject to passing an entrance test and interview and availability of seats.**
