Dear Professor N. Mekoth.

Following our recent meeting, I would like to bring to you some points on the Joaquim Heliodoro da Cunha Rivara Chair, funded by Camões, I.P., and established at Goa University through the Protocol of Cooperation (Memorandum of Agreement) signed on 07th April 2016.

The current M.O.A is ending shortly and a renewal for another period is to be defined.

Presently, and according to the Protocol, an Organizing Committee, created vide Order of Goa University dated 08/06/2016, is responsible for the plan of the annual activities of the J H Cunha Rivara Chair and for the selection of the Visiting Professors.

I would like to propose the integration of the J H da Cunha Rivara Chair under the same Directorate of Visiting Research Professors Programme functioning at Goa University since 2013-2014, maintaining the basic conditions laid down in the current M.O.A.

For that, the inclusion of the *Leitor*/Head of Centro de Língua Portuguesa/Camões in Panjim in the Organizing Committee of the DVRPP, Goa University may be considered. The Head of CLP/Camões may also be designated as Coordinator of the J H Rivara Chair in order to report the activities and statement of accounts, of this particular chair, to Camões headquarters.

The Department of Portuguese and Lusophone Studies will continue to propose in BOS meeting the approval of the credit courses and the course-coordinator.

Following the interaction stablished between the Goa University and me into the framework of the Joaquim Heliodoro da Cunha Rivara Chair, and after some informal talks on the subject, as Chair Influence from the UNESCO Chair in Intercultural Dialogue in Heritages of Portuguese suggest Goa University to also become member.

The reasons are obvious, but it is relevant that you can have a precise idea about the *Patrimonios* ("Heritages" in Portuguese becomes the nick name we all use to designate it). For that see with the proposal under which UNESCO has decided to grant the Universidade de Coimbra training and knowledge exchange into the main objectives of the Patrimónios are the research, Specifically relevant is the fact we mention there the cooperation we developed before through invite. One of the two others (Lúrio) has already be integrated.

In September the agreement has been signed and we are finally installing the light structure that will support it. The *Patrimonios* is the result of a PhD programme we have been running before, so have yet some projects in progress. One of the compromises we have with UNESCO is the publication twice a year of a newsletter — the *Carta Patrimónios* — which 1st number has been release a few weeks ago and I have the pleasure to also attach to this letter.

The UNESCO Chair in Intercultural Dialogue in the Heritage of Portuguese Influence and the PhD course of the same name [both Patrimónios], promote integrated interdisciplinary cooperation and research about the assets that, from the point of view of active cultural heritage (architecture, arts, language, literature, landscape, urbanism), entail convergences in recognising the values common to the communities where Portuguese forms of presence have existed, or still exist. Its focus is not the latter, but the variety of cultural outcomes it has generated in the world, recognising the role of the 'other', the co-constitution and multi-directionalism of North-South and South-South relations, the consequences of movements and processes of violent subjugation implicit in the phenomena of emigration and colonisation, as well as new or renewed forms of post-colonial domination.

The chair Patrimónios is based on a number of previous initiatives, not least the opening, in 2010, by the Institute for Interdisciplinary Research and the Centre for Social Studies of the University of Coimbra, of a PhD course which includes the branches of Cultural Studies and Architecture and Urbanism, with 4 editions and 8 PhD theses concluded. With competitive funding from the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation, in 2014 it evolved into a network that includes five other universities (Bologna, Federal Fluminense, Eduardo Mondlane, Paris Nanterre and Algarve) and launched several initiatives that have established it as a space for critical thinking in cooperation for development. The Camões, Institute of Cooperation and Language has also recognised the efforts of Patrimónios, both in terms of culture and cooperation, by supporting innumerable initiatives through a collaboration protocol. Patrimónios has been integrated into the University of Coimbra strategic initiatives of similar scope, such as the AltaSophia project (2014-2015) and, more actively, with the inclusion of the University of Coimbra Alta and Sofia in the UNESCO World Heritage List. The successful internationalisation effort and the recruitment of students within the Portuguese-speaking culture and research spheres are more examples of intense institutional collaboration with the University of Coimbra.

As a consequence of this strategic collaboration, the Rectory has invited Patrimónios to apply for the UNESCO Chair in Intercultural Dialogue in Heritage of Portuguese Influence, which was approved by that agency of the United Nations last June. Its network includes the aforementioned Patrimónios partner universities, together with Lúrio University (Nampula, Mozambique), MEIA, the University Institute of Art, Technology and Culture (Mindelo, Cabo Verde), the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation and the Camões, Institute of Cooperation and Language. Active cooperation in training, capacity building and research on cultural heritage is its structuring purpose, in line with the UNESCO Strategic Objectives and the Education 2030 Agenda, and in general with the United Nations 2030 Agenda/Sustainable Development Goals.

This first issue of the Carta Patrimónios (Heritage Letter) marks the beginning of a new phase of this collective project, which crosses disciplines and geographies, mobilizes multiple knowledge and institutions, and promotes a critical and pluralistic view of cultural heritage and its importance for understanding the past, questioning the present and, together and in open dialogue, imagining a future based on sustainable development processes.
