**The objectives / description of the
activity (50 words)**

Varieties of Konkani spoken in the northern part of Goa is infused with oral traditions manifested in Jaat, Sokarat, Fugadi, Dhalo, Folk Drama, Lullabies, Hovyo (Lagn Geeta) folk tales, creation myths, ballads and rituals etc.. Oral narratives have helped these communities to negotiate the cultural amnesia brought on by modern education in the language other than own and other forces of change. Myths and narrations are instrumental to perpetuate knowledge, values and aesthetics of human thoughts and actions. Creation Tales play an important role in maintaining social cohesion and friendship. However, one must realize that these forms of oral tradition and IK imbibed in the language are soon to be evaporated in the wake of modernization of societies. Speedy and early documentation by scientific methods is very necessary. Hence the proposal for training the participants in documenting IK and OT of Konkani.




