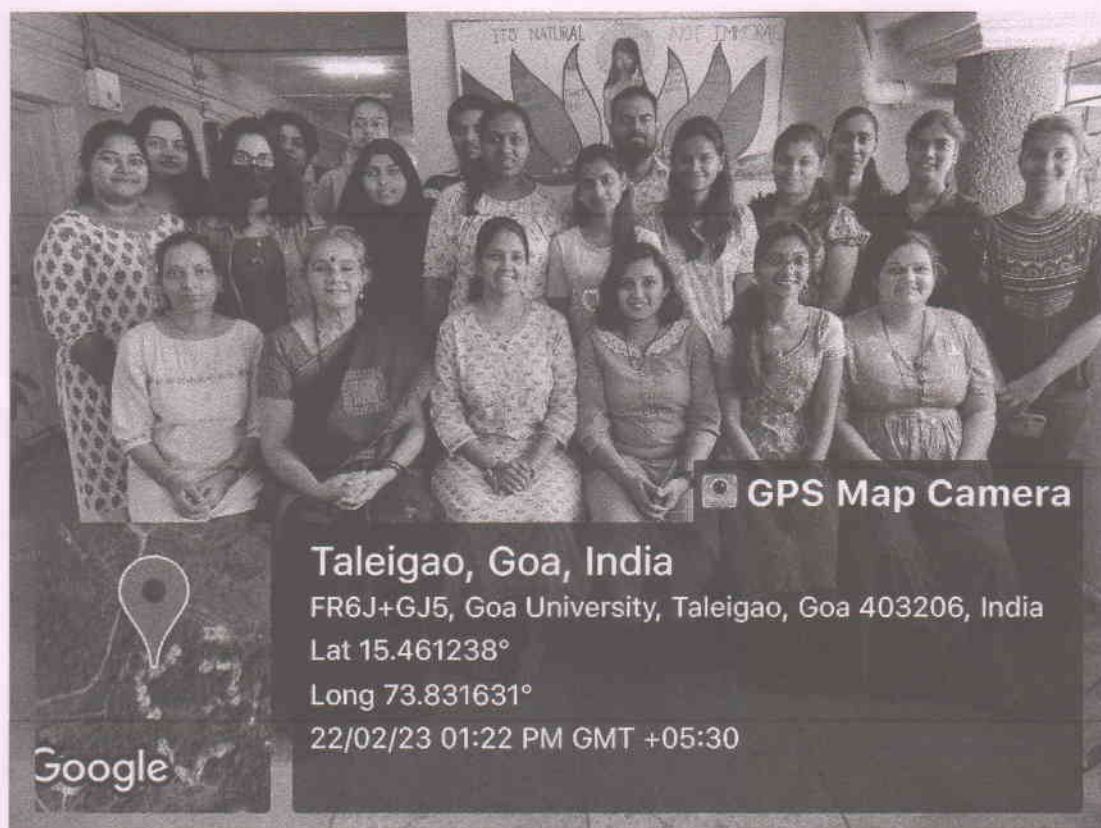
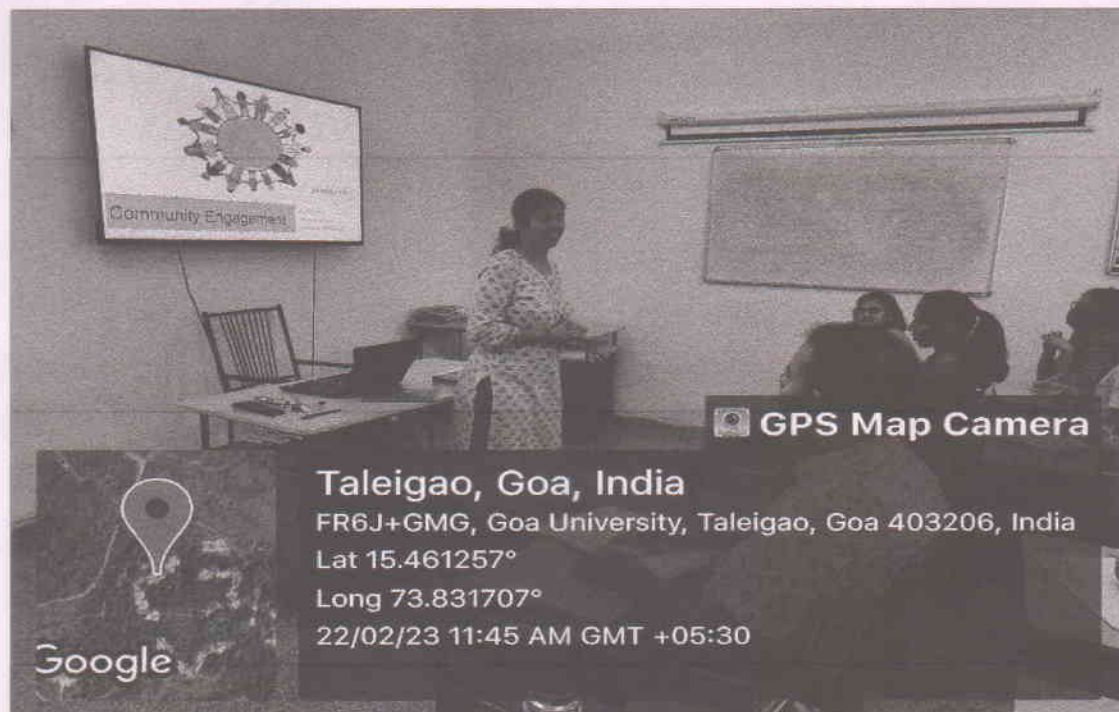


Figure 2 Speaker discussing about the Counselling skills
