III-Enabling in proper implementation of laws: Rescue, Medical, - Services at Protective home, Repatriation, - Reintegration He spoke of the PILs filed on Baina Demolition and improving the conditions of Protective Home.
Benefit/Key outcome of the event	The students through his lecture were able to understand practical and field level interventions that are possible through the law in social work settings. They also understood the difficulties encountered in working with the system and the need for sustained advocacy to achieve change.
