The objective/description of the activity	The purpose of the guest lecture was to introduce to the students the debates around the question of development through the effects of mining on water resources. Ramesh Gauns spoke of how several water resources are affected because of development which is centered on mining. He also spoke of the effects on mining on ground water table, agriculture and social life. He gave examples of studies of the alcoholism in mining area. Citing World Bank statistics about the projected water scarcity by 2025, he concluded the lecture by stating that the choice is simple, we need to choose what is more important for our development, is it mines or is it water?




