




11. Description of the Program/activity/event	<p>Dr. Shanbhogue provided insights into the history of Mopa Airport and its significance as Goa's second airport. He discussed Goa's development since liberation, touching on revenue sources and the state's control over the power sector. He considered the Mopa airport project, which was initiated in 1977 and completed in 2022, as his personal "baby." Dr. Shanbhogue detailed the project's history, the challenges it faced—such as legal issues and land acquisition—and the efforts made in replantation, rehabilitation, and skill development.</p> <p>In the second session, Dr. Shanbhogue explored public-private partnerships (PPP), explaining why PPPs are chosen and discussing various types of contracts, such as design-build and joint ventures. He emphasized the importance of risk allocation and project preparation for PPP success. The final session was an interactive Q&A, where the audience actively engaged with the speaker.</p>
12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	<p>Students gained valuable knowledge about the Mopa Airport project and its role in Goa's growth. They also developed a clear understanding of PPP models, their benefits, and how they are implemented in infrastructure projects like the Mopa Airport.</p>
