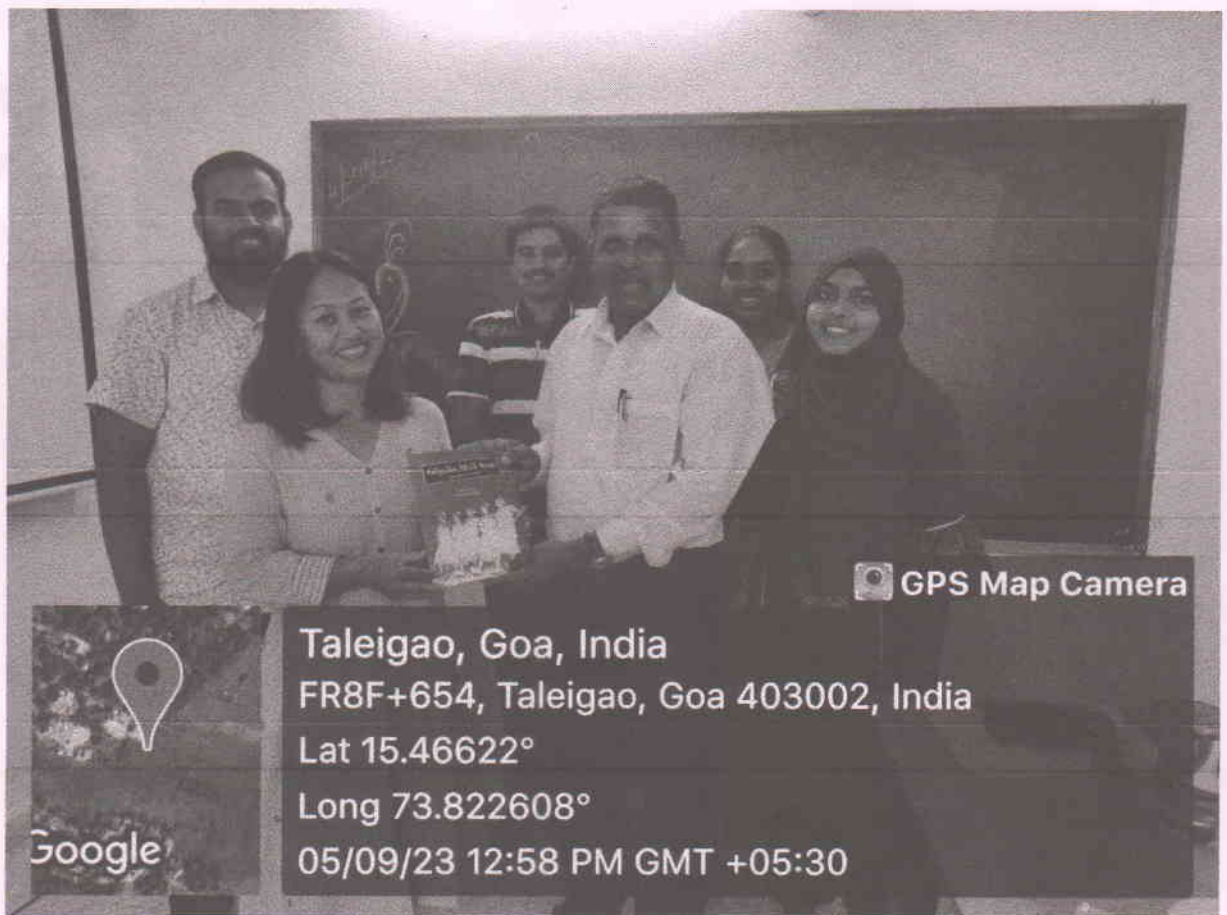

10. Is a member of Sahitya Academy, Konkani advisory board.








