A trained Psychologist by profession. Working at Sangath, one of leading mental health research organisation in India for the last 25 years. Work primarily involves developing and evaluating interventions for children, youth and women. Currently leads the ***School Mental Health Program*** in Pune and Gadchiroli districts of Maharashtra and ***Zippy's Friends***, a program building Coping and Resilience Skills in Primary School Children.

She has led pilot, acceptability and feasibility studies, cluster randomised control trials as well as scaling-up programs on adolescent health and well-being. Prachi has contributed to book chapter, journal articles, and presented conference papers on adolescent and young people's health.

Prachi has experience of working with national and state governments, national and international NGOs, grassroots organisations and wide range of stakeholders on programme development, training and implementation. She has worked with various types of school systems, intervention delivery agents in different parts of India and with different target groups (normal and vulnerable adolescents, women and children).

Prachi serves on the Counseling Cell of the Goa Education Development Corporation (GEDC), Govt of Goa. The cell is responsible for training supervising and mentoring around 80+ professionally trained counselors providing counseling services in around 200+ secondary and higher secondary schools in Goa under the Goa Counseling Scheme.

Prachi also works with issues such as child protection and family/domestic violence. Has served on the Juvenile Justice Board, under the Juvenile Justice Care and Protection amended Act, 2015. She has served as a member on the Goa State Commission for the Protection of Child Rights, which is a recommendatory body on child rights Ex-member on the Goa State Commission for the Protection of Child Rights, my role here involved analyzing and checking the non-implementation of existing law, policy and practice to assess compliance with Convention on the Rights of the Child, inquire into violation of child rights and recommend initiation of proceedings. Look into the matters relating to need of care and protection of marginalized and vulnerable children. Inspect any juvenile home or place of residence or institution meant for children and inquire into complaints and take suo-motto notice of matters related with violation of child rights. Conduct trainings for parents and teachers on effective parenting and disciplinary practices

Empanelled as a Counselor for Courts of law in Goa for cases under matrimonial disputes and Domestic Violence Act.

Serves as a member on 'Sexual Harassment at Workplace Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)' for various Educational Institutions, Corporates/Companies and government departments in Goa. Role on ICC involves conducting awareness program and handle cases under the sexual harassment of women at workplace (prevention, prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013.

Prachi loves leading challenging projects, visiting new places, meeting people and spending quality time with her family.
