The objective	To understand the contemporary women's issues faced by women in Goa	
Description of the activity	The lecture delivered by Advocate Albertina Almeida raised different issues encountered by women in Goa in the contemporary times. She began with the discussion by saying that all issues are women's issues. Basically focussed on property right, adoption, depleting sex ratio, drug abuse, Alcoholism, tourism and diseases affects women. She gave very important message most of issues have greater impact on women but we hardly realises that. She raised concerns about women and reproductive issues, how women coming from lower castes encounter different problems than women coming from higher caste backgrounds and gave insights on intersectionality and invisibilities of women's work. She also touched upon the property rights of women in their maternal place, gendersensitive financial budgeting and human rights standards for women in Goa as a myth.	
Benefit/Key outcome of the event	Students advanced their knowledge as the lecture covered most of the issues related to women in Goa. Students were able to understand the reality of women behind the bigger picture of development we often carry in Goa saying and thinking that Goa is a developed state. She focussed on the fact that the laws should be non-discriminatory and the state must make unbiassed laws with special provisions for women and have a gender-sensitive approach.




