- CCSEA members raised some queries regarding the number of mice to be used by Dr. Avelyno D'Costa, who later provided the breakup for each test and the members were satisfied. He was permitted to use 15 mice for nano studies, 15 for toxicity evaluation and 30 for geno and neurotoxic studies.
- CCSEA members approved the use of fish % specimens of 4 different species for Mrs. Santoshi Narvekar to prepare the hydrosylates but not the experiments on mice at the moment for which she would apply for the following year.
- CCSEA members suggested to Dr. Preeti Pereira to reduce the number of Sea anemones from 30 to 25 specimens.

Ms Gandhita was permitted to use 40 guppies for her experiment and 50 Mackerels and 50 shrimps.

Rest of the project proposals were approved as presented and mentioned in the proposals.

AOB: The Member Secretary informed the members that the main nominee, Dr Chandrashekar K was not cooperative and was not available to hold the meeting of the IAEC and was very rude during telephonic conversation. Therefore his authoritative approach was so stressful to schedule the meeting. The situation was that there were 48 proposals which include the work of dissertation as a part of successful completion of post graduate degree as well as PhD and R&D projects. Additionally the chairperson (VC) was going out of the country for a fortnight. Hence, inspite of explaining all the above the main nominee was non cooperative. However, the link-nominee, Dr Indrajeet Gonjari was later kind enough to be present online and thus the meeting could be scheduled and needful could be done. The members thus felt that there was a need to change the Main Nominee as he was not cooperative, rude in his behavior and inordinate delay in attending all the previous meetings. Thereafter he arrived after most of the proposals were already presented. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.



The Chairman welcomed all the members of the Committee

As per the agenda of the meeting twenty-three new protocols were reviewed and discussed by the members. The CPCSEA and other IAEC members deliberated on each proposal, leading to informed decisions.

Dr. Chandrashekar expressed a concern regarding the inclusion of proposals related to fish, while other members felt that discussing these proposals could be beneficial. Dr. Indrajeet suggested that the discussions could help inform a more thoughtful decision.

Dr. Chandashekar requested the veterinarian's opinion on proposals numbered 3, 4, 6, 7, and 8. The said protocols were placed before Dr. Gustav Pinto, after examining the veterinarian, provided consent and approval for these proposals.

Regarding Proposal No. 11, which pertained to a workshop, Dr. Chandashekar advised that a veterinarian should be present during the handling of animals by participants to ensure precautionary measures are taken. Dr. Pinto agreed with this recommendation.

During the discussion of proposals Serial Number 17, 18, 19, and 20, Dr. Nitin, the Member Secretary, recused himself, as there were protocols pertaining to students working with his guidance. Dr. Chandashekar raised concerns about proposals 18 and 19, which involved insects and spiders, emphasizing the need for proper training for students and the provision of precautionary medication, as advised by the veterinarian. Dr. Pinto clarified that no injections are necessary for handling spiders and insects.

Dr. Nitin Sawant confirmed his commitment to providing proper training and overseeing the handling of animals by students. Ultimately, all proposals were approved as presented.




