This is to certify that Dr. Natasha Maria Gomes, participated as a developer in OE4BW International online mentoring program from December 2023 to October 2024, which is organized by University of Nova Gorica and UNESCO Chair on Open Technologies for Open Educational Resources (OER) and Open Learning at the Jožef Stefan Institute.
