Objective: To increase productivity of Deejay Sampoorna hybrids through improved plant nutrition and health, stress tolerance, soil structure and fertility.

Introduction: The occurrence of mixed populations of Arbuscular mycorrhizal (AM) fungi have been commonly recorded for the coconut rhizosphere soils. In coconut, the AM root colonisation is highly symbiotic helping in the uptake of P and other immobile elements. The symbiosis can also improve host responses to environmental limitations like water stress, resistance to pathogenic fungi and pests, etc.

The consortium of three dominant AM fungal species will be multiplied and used as inoculum (along with other suitable amendments) to inoculate another 2500 coconut trees.

- 1. In the present consultancy, Deejay Farms will seek guidance from Prof. Bernard F. Rodrigues of Goa University to inoculate 2500 coconut trees under phase IV at Deejay Farms Uguem, with AM fungal consortium.
