Proposal

Elections are fundamental to democratic governance. They not only facilitate smooth transfer of power but also provide means to citizens to hold their representatives accountable. Conducting free and fair elections in a country with huge population and geographical diversities is a challenging task. The task of Election Commission of India (ECI) in this regard is commendable. Apart from the conduct of free and fair elections, in recent years ECI have initiated many activities to gauge the voters knowledge, belief, perception, attitude, practices and behaviour towards elections and tried to ease the process of voting so that large number of people can cast their vote. Almost all polling booths are disabled friendly. It also took measures to reduce money power at the time of elections. The enrolment drives and voter campaigns increased voter turnout. These activities increased awareness among the voters about the process of elections in India.

Due to the efforts of office of Chief Electoral Officer, Goa witnessed an increase in the voting turnout in the previous assembly and Loksabha elections. The Department of Political Science has become part of one such activity started by the ECI called SVEEP. The Department was involved in conducting baseline and endline surveys for Loksabha and Assembly elections of Goa in the past. In continuation with this collaboration, the Department of Political Science proposes to conduct the KAP Baseline and Endline Surveys for the Goa Assembly Elections 2022.

Objectives

- 1. To understand awareness of election process among the voters of Goa.
- 2. To study the attitude of voters towards election.
- 3. To examine the behaviour of voters towards registration and voting.
- 4. To study awareness about ECI's campaign among voters of Goa.

Research Methodology

Goa is divided into two districts, North Goa and South Goa. Data will be collected from 12 Assembly Constituencies, six Assembly Constituencies from each District. From each Assembly Constituency, four Polling Stations (PSs) will be selected and from each Polling Station 15 respondents will be selected for the survey. The Assembly Constituencies and Polling Stations will be selected using stratified random sampling method. Enumerators will use KRIS grid formula. One enumerator will cover two polling stations (30 respondents). The data will be collected from both quantitative as well as qualitative methods. The quantitative method includes survey which will be conducted through a structured questionnaire. Since the information on knowledge, attitude and belief will be collected it is called the KAB tool. The questionnaire will be administered to the registered voters in Goa.
