The objective/description of the activity	 #DaanUtsav is India's biggest 'festival of giving' during which people come together and perform acts of kindness by giving their time or material towards a cause.

- This campaign at Goa University was a student-driven initiative, wherein two Part 1- Social Work students placed in El-Shaddai NGO for fieldwork worked in the Community Centre at Chimbel slum where they were working with 50+ underprivileged children (i.e., children of construction workers, street children and children living in slum area).
- The El-Shaddai team and our PG students created a wish tree and donation boxes on campus
- The students, faculty members, administrative staff of Goa University and the general public anonymously donated generously.
- Collected items were handed over by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Goa University, Prof. Harilal Menon in the presence of Dean, MPSLGPP, Programme Director, Faculty Coordinator of Daan Utsav & all faculty members of MPSLGPP and students of Social Work programme to the El-Shaddai team on 11th October 2023
- El- Shaddai who received the donations on behalf of El-Shaddai beneficiaries expressed gratitude to Goa University for organizing Daan Utsav as this event will help in supporting their cause.

Benefit/Key outcome of the event

• Through this campaign, we were able to collect school stationery (notebooks, tiffins, water bottles, story books, drawing and painting material; educational toys; toiletries (bath, washing and oral hygiene products) and grocery

items (rice, millets, pulses, oil, biscuits, atta, soya chunks, sugar and biscuits) for the 150+ underprivileged children approximately worth Rs. 25,000 approximately.

- The collection will support El Shaddai's cause of giving free meals daily to 150 children of construction workers in Goa.
- The educational toys and stationery will be used to educate underprivileged children through community centres in slum areas.




