Report of Microbiologists Society India (MBSI) Student Unit of SEOAS for the academic year 2021-22

The Student Unit of Microbiologists Society, India was initiated in December 2022 with student membership of 29 students (https://microbiosociety.com/college-having-students-unit/).

Ms. Ruta Sawant from MSc Part I (Marine Microbiology) and Ayman Khan from MSc Part II (Marine Microbiology) were selected as student representatives. The membership collected and the expenditure of which is as below:

Total membership for 2021-22 = 2400 (new) + 750 (renewed) = Rs. 3150/-

Amount transferred to MBSI = 20% of 3150 = Rs. 650/-

Balance amount remaining = 3150 - 650 = Rs. 2500/-

The balance membership is to be used for organisation of various activities.

Inorder to create awareness among students about antibiotic resistance and role of microbiology in CoViD 19, the student unit organised Microbiology Awareness Week with 2 activities, poster competition and an essay competition in March 2022, wherein three best posters and essays were selected. The judge for the competition was Dr. Varsha Ghadyale, Head, Department of Biochemistry, Gogate Jogalekar College, Ratnagiri.
