This is to CONFIRM our commitment to collaborate with the Manohar Parrikar School of Law, Governance and Public Policy (MPSLGPP) at Goa University (GU).

As indicated in the approved document (Collaboration with Goa University) emailed to you 25th March 2024, we remain committed to the following financial commitment:

- i. This shortlisted cohort of 4/5 students will receive as reimbursements from the Living Waters Museum (LWM) for research field trips on submission of research output deliverables (up to a sum of INR 5000.00 per month for a period of three months, on submission of certification by the concerned signatories). This will be verified and certified by the respective guides and Sulochana Pednekar.
- ii. The total sum of student reimbursements for 4/5 students towards 3 months of expenditure will be transferred to MPSLGPP at GU from LWM. Disbursements to the students will be made in two stages. The first reimbursement payment will be paid out at the mid-way point (6 weeks) and the second reimbursement on submission of approved and completed deliverables. MPSLGPP will implement a systematic impact assessment mechanism to evaluate the tangible outcomes of the workshop in collaboration with LWM.
- iii. Apart from this payment LWM will make no additional Admisnistrative payments nor charges to Goa University.

We look forward to signing all necessary documents and the completion of all necessary formalities at the earliest and initiate the collaborative programme with the students.
