Duration of study:

The academic year at UiT starts in August and end in June. The duration of your study is dependant on the level/type of programme you are given admission to:

- One-year programmes: 1 academic year (2 semesters).
- Master degree programmes: 2 academic years (4 semesters), with the exception of "**Law of the Sea - Master**": 1,5 academic years (3 semesters).
- Bachelor degree programmes: 3 academic years (6 semesters).

NB. Transfer to another academic programme are not allowed.
