## Online discussion session on Premchand Jayanti in Hindi Department of Goa University

An online discussion on the occasion of the 140th birth anniversary of Premchand was organized on Google Meet by the Hindi Department of Goa University on 29 July 2020. By the way, when I read and study Premchand and think about this subject with my hobby, it seems that I have had many meetings with Premchand. Manisha Gaude, the assistant professor of the department said that my first meeting with Premchand was through the characters of the Panch Parmeshwar story. He said that while reading the Panch Parmeshwar story, I felt that the characters of the story are around me. The old lady of the story looked to me like the Aji living in my neighbourhood. The keynote speaker of the discussion, Dr. Pradeep Kumar, quoted from the book 'Guruji Ki Khetibaadi' by critic Vishwanath Tripathi ji, referring to his first meeting through the story 'Bade Bhai Saahab'. He said that the first meeting with Premchand goes to critic Vishwanath Tripathi. Tripathi ji mentioned the story of Premchand's elder brother on several occasions. Regarding the story, he used to say again and again that elder brother sahib is not a story, it is life. I found this story as a challenge at times while doing theatrical adaptation of the story.
