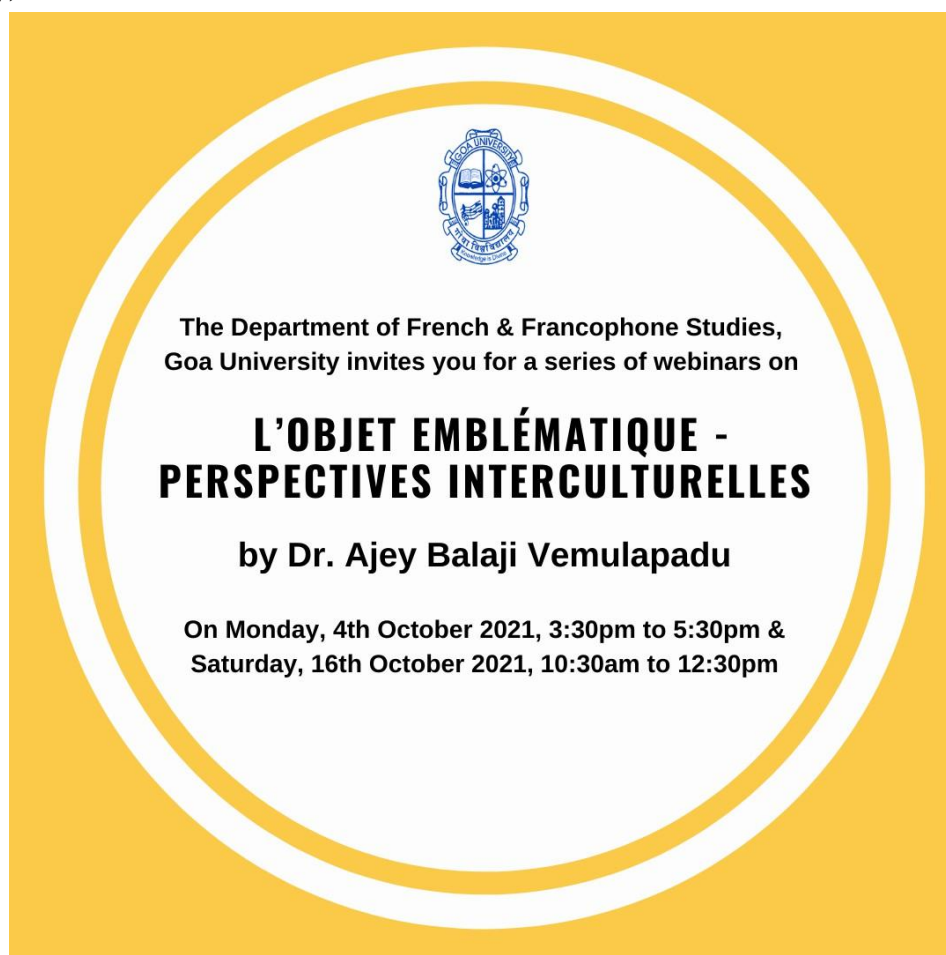


**REPORT-**

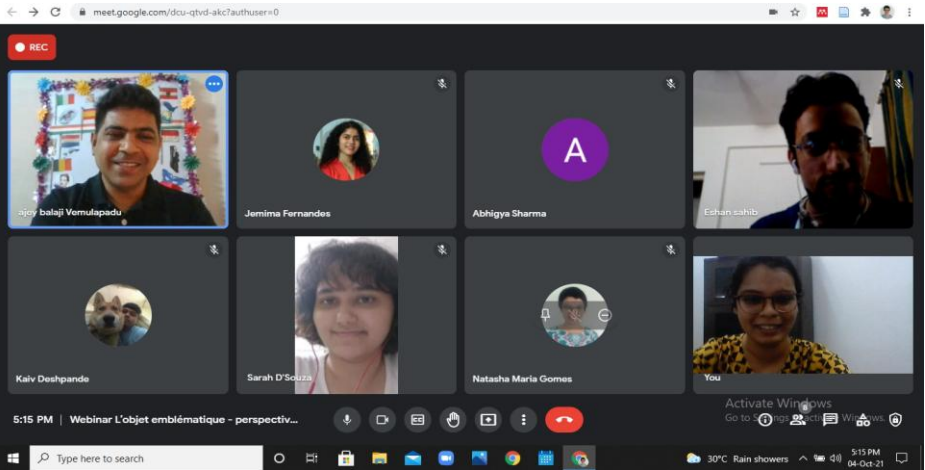
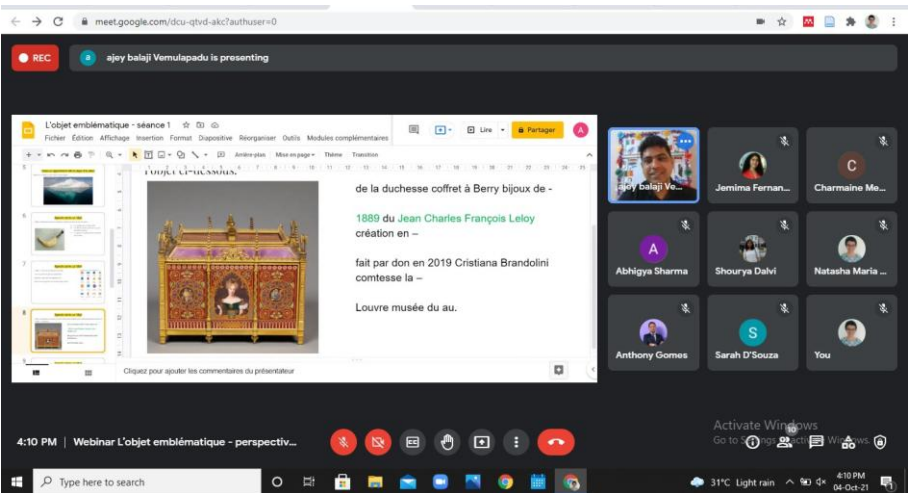
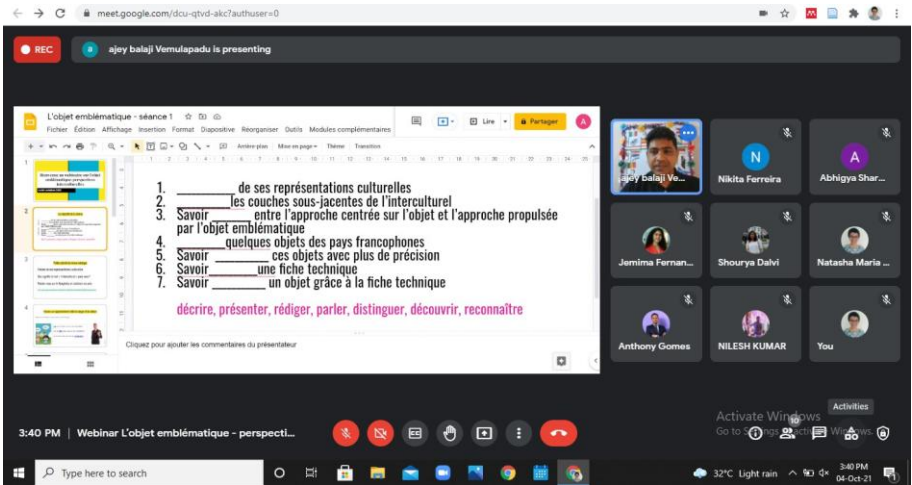
