

BADMINTON RULES


DOUBLES TOURNAMENT.

- Combined team weight should not exceed 625kg



Report

The Department of Zoology organized an inter-departmental 'Sports week', from 18th -22nd April 2022. The M.sc. students, Mr. Viraj Vaigankar and Mr. Sanjit Gaonkar were the student coordinators. M.Sc. Part 1, M.Sc. Part 2 and Ph.D. students of Zoology Department volunteered to organize the event.

Eight departments/programme of Goa University participated in the event, namely: Geology, Marine Biotechnology, Marine Microbiology, Environmental Science, General Biotechnology, Botany, Marine Science, and Zoology. The event comprised of 4 tournaments i.e. badminton, tug of war, penalty shootout and control cricket.

At the end of the tournaments, the points scored by the 1st 3 teams were as follows:-


Geology- 500, Marine biotechnology- 475, Zoology- 350

On 22nd April, after the final event, prize distribution was done. Trophies and medals were presented to the winners. The event ended with the vote of thanks by the student.


