Refresher Course in English (INTERDISCIPLINARY)

REPORT

1. UGC-HRDC, Goa University has conducted its Refresher Course in English (Inter-disciplinary) through (Online mode). A total of 39 participants registered for the course. The Participants were from the state of Goa, and other states also Maharashtra, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Meghalaya, Rajasthan, Bihar, Gujarat, Assam and Kerala. Most of the participants attended the Online Refresher Course in English (Inter-disciplinary) were from outstation. It may also be noted that the Gender wise bifurcation of the participants is as follows :
Male - 22 Participants and Female – 17 Participants.
2. Prof. Ms. Purva Hegde Desai, In charge Director, HRDC welcomed the Resource Person and the participants of the Refresher Course. In her introductory remarks Prof. Purva mentioned that the Language is the mirror of personality and also the language is the mirror to the culture of a place, all of us do need soft skills. Further, Prof. Purva also highlighted on the language that consists of group discussion, presentation skills and so on. English is presently the global link language and therefore has its own significance at a global national level. Dr. Chandrakant A Langare, Associate Professor, Shivaji University, Kolhapur, has inaugurated the Refresher Course in English (Inter-disciplinary) in the presence of Prof. Ms. Purva G. Hegde Desai, In-Charge Director and Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth, Assistant Professor, UGC-HRDC. The Chief Guest addressed the participants focusing on the books that take care of all the language skills. He mentioned that reading is very important and the refresher courses will help in understanding the own culture. Teaching community is the ray of hope. The Course was Co-ordinated by Prof. K. S. Bhat, Professor in English, Shenoji Goembab School of Languages and Literature, Goa University. The course was divided into 4 lecture sessions from (a) 10.00 am – 11.30 am (b) 11.45 am – 1.15 pm (c) 2.00 pm – 3.30 pm (d) 3.45 pm – 5.15 pm . with a lunch-break of 45 minutes duration.

- 3 The Course was enriched with most eminent resource persons across the country. Due to the Interdisciplinary nature of the course many new areas were covered such as Cultural Studies, Memory Studies, Diaspora Studies, Partition Literature, Graphic Literature, Film Studies, disability Studies and so on. The participants were from the various disciplines. Some of the topics that were presented by the participants are: (i) Portuguese Colony (ii) Unique Manifestations of Spirituality, Humanism and Virtue in the Poems of Rabindranath Tagor (iii) The Goddess of Revenge – as a Feminist Text (iv) Public Speaking (v) Pre-Independence Indian English Novel (vi) Spiritual Reflection in Sudhir Kakar' Ecstasy (vii) Literary Translation within the premises of children's and juvenile fantasy literatur (viii) The Intermingling of History and Folk elements in the Popular narratives of the Kappiri Myth (ix) A Critical Analysis in Arundathi Roy's "The God of small things" (x) Environmental Concerns and North American Writing.
- 4 Further, the participants were requested to write Major Research Project Proposal as per UGC format, which was later evaluated by the Course Coordinator. The participants were also requested to submit the Seminar Presentation Report on the topic of their choice, which was assessed simultaneously. At the end, the participants answered the objective type test, which was evaluated and graded accordingly.
- 5 The valedictory function was held on 15th February 2023. The valedictory address was delivered by the Chief Guest Dr. Sanjay Kisan Khilare, Vidya Pratishtan's A.S.C. College Vidyanagari, Pune. Dr. Sanjay shared the stories of a Bumblebee and also requested the young participants to face challenges and fly in one's own career. Further he has requested the English teachers to start translation and make matter available in their own language. An English teacher should try and explore the possibilities and bring change the complete scenario of the classroom, and this is how the teachers can explore the world. The course ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Ingrid Anne Nazareth, Assistant Professor, UGC - HRDC, Goa University.
