Short Term Course on Human Rights and Conflict Management (Online)

From 21/02/2023 to 27/02/2023

REPORT

1. UGC-HRDC, Goa University conducted its Short Term Course on Human Rights and Conflict Management (Online). Twenty Four participants registered for the course. Participants were from Goa, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Bihar, West Bengal, Himachal Pradesh, and Kerala. Majority of the participants were from the State of Maharashtra. There were 01 local and 23 outstation participants. The Course was conducted under the leadership of Director-in-Charge, Prof. Purva Hegde Desai, and coordinated by Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth, Assistant Professor, HRDC, Goa University.
2. Prof. Purva welcomed the participants for the inaugural function of the Short Term Course. In her introductory remarks Prof. Purva mentioned that as a lay man sometimes gets confused about what are the real Human Rights and Responsibilities associated with Human Rights. Further she mentioned that the Diversity is the sole of Human race. The Human rights and responsibilities which will enable the conflicts to be managed and would be lived peacefully with each other. The Short Term Course was inaugurated by Prof. Shaber Ali, Officiating Principal, V. M. Salgaonkar College of Law, Miramar Panaji Goa. Prof. Shaber Ali opening remarks described on the concept of Human Rights, Stages of Human development, Modern Documents on Human Rights. Further he mentioned that the rights available to a person because he is born as a Human. Human Rights is striking in its care, its vision and its relevance to modern times. The unique feature of the Human Right in Islam are the natural outcome of a broader practice of faith. In his conclusion remarks Prof. Shaber Ali mentioned that "making a law is no use unless it is implemented". Law should be in spirit not in theory. Awareness – through Seminars, workshop, skit etc. Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth gave a brief overview of the course and gave the vote of thanks.
3. Four lecture sessions were delivered daily in an online mode between 10:00 a.m.-11.30 am, 11.45 am – 1.15 pm, 02.00 pm – 03.30 pm and 3.45 pm - 5:15 pm. with a lunch-

break of 45 minutes duration at 1:15 p.m. The Course was enriched with well experienced resource persons from across the Goa and other States also..

- 4 Some of the lecture topics delivered by Resource Persons during the programme were as follows: (1) Human Rights – The Legal Fundamentals (2) Human Rights : An Interdisciplinary perspective (3) Gender Equality & Women's Rights – Why are we still unable to realize this in India? A perspective (4) Conflict Management Policy and Practice in South and Southeast Asia (5) International Human Rights (6) National Mechanisms on Human Rights (7) Protection of Human Rights under Indian Law (8) Conflict Management (9) Initiatives of Parliament and its Committee System on Human Rights (10) Human Rights of Children – The Legal Imperatives .
- 5 Prof. Purva welcomed the participants for the valedictory function of the Short Term Course. Prof. Saba Da Silva, delivered the valedictory speech to the participants. Prof. Saba mentioned that Human Rights must be protected by Law. According to United Nations there are 30 basic rights, but seven are most fundamental they are : (i) Right to Life (ii) Right to Marry (iii) Right to equal treatment (iv) Right to work (v) Right to education (vi) Right to enjoy (vii) Right to Privacy. Lastly some of the participants gave their feedback about the course. Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth read the course report and gave the vote of thanks.
