Short Term Course on Coastal Tourism and Environment (Online)

From 08/03/2023 to 14/03/2023

REPORT

1. UGC-HRDC, Goa University conducted its Short Term Course on Coastal Tourism and Environment (Online). Twenty participants registered for the course. Participants were from Goa, Maharashtra, Assam, Tamil Nadu, and Kerala. Majority of the participants were from the State of Maharashtra. There were 01 local and 19 outstation participants. The Course was conducted under the leadership of Director-in-Charge, Prof. Purva Hegde Desai, and coordinated by Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth, Assistant Professor, HRDC, Goa University.
2. Prof. Purva welcomed the participants for the inaugural function of the Short Term Course. In her brief welcome address Prof. Purva mentioned that Goa lives from Coastal Tourism and lives us an understatement because Coastal Tourism has made Goa a top State in per capita income of this country and therefore it is our secret duty to preserve our coast line. The Short Term Course was inaugurated by Prof. C.U Rivonkar, Dean, School of Earth, Ocean & Atmospheric Sciences, Goa University. Prof. Rivonkar in his opening remarks described the insights of Goa which probably need to be considered. Tourism Industry growing in a faster space as far as Coastal States are concerned. Prof. Rivonkar also spoke on (a) Impacts on Environment. (b) Coastal Regulation Zone and different Coast lines of the Country & different activities based on it and important requirement one have to take care of one's own Eco System and Coastal Tourism. (c) Coastal Habitat degradation and change in land based activities in future. Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth gave a brief overview of the course and gave the vote of thanks.
3. Four lecture sessions were delivered daily in an online mode between 10:00 a.m.-11.30 am, 11.45 am – 1.15 pm, 02.00 pm – 03.30 pm and 3.45 pm - 5:15 pm. with a lunch-break of 45 minutes duration at 1:15 p.m. The Course was enriched with well experienced resource persons from across the Goa and other States also.
4. Some of the lecture topics delivered by Resource Persons during the programme were as follows: (1) Prospective Zones for Eco-tourism in Goa – Needs and Constraints (2)

Coastal Tourism - Initiatives of Indian Parliament & its Committee System (3) Coastal Tourism - Opportunities & Challenges (4) Sustaining a Coastal Destination (5) Sustainable Tourism Development Issues and Challenges (6) Coastal Eco Tourism Determinants and Environmental Sustainability : A Conceptual framework for community involvement in Developing Coastal Karnataka (7) Ecotourism for conserving the Coastal Environment (8) Sustainable Coastal tourism : Issues and opportunities (9) Water based Tourism (10) Coastal Tourism in Goa : Impact on Beach-Dune Ecosystems .


5 **Prof. Purva** welcomed the participants for the valedictory function of the Short Term Course. Dr. Antonio Mascarenhas, Former Scientist, National Institute of Oceanography, Goa, delivered the valedictory speech to the participants. Dr. Antonio spoke on Insights of Coastal Tourism and the beach Dunes. He also mentioned that **"A sandy beach belongs to the Ocean, a sandy beach does not belong to the people"** because the ocean comes to the beach to rest. The beach has to be as wide as possible so that the coastal Ecosystem should survive. Further Prof. Antonio also presented on the following points :

(i) Role of Beach - Dune Ecosystems (ii) Response of Sand Dunes after the Tsunami (iii) Coastal Regulation Zone Notification (iv) Human interference on Dune Fields (v) Some Conservation & Restoration Measures. Finally some of the participants gave their feedback about the course. Dr. Ingrid Anne P. Nazareth read the course report and gave the vote of thanks.
