- For images, text equivalent is provided by using the ALT attribute. The ALT text for an image
 is displayed before the image is fully downloaded. It is the main source of image information
 for users of text-only browsers, users of browsers with graphics turned off and users who
 are sight impaired.
- 2. All the video links available on the website are linked through the university's official YouTube Channel.
- 3. The screen reader's speech output can be heard clearly without interference from other audio, which is especially important for those who are hard of hearing or have hearing impairments.
- 4. On our website, the visual presentation of text and images of text has a contrast ratio of 8.59:1 (https://wave.webaim.org/report#/www.unigoa.ac.in)
- 5. Some PDF documents available/linked on the website are not OCR documents. The screen reader can read the type and size of a file.
- 6. On the website, there are no special effects such as blinking, or flashing which are reported to cause epileptic seizures. Scrolling contents can be paused by hovering cursor in the box.
- 7. "Skip to Main Navigation | Skip to Main Content" links exist on the website.
- 8. On the website, a link to a "Search" page from every page of the website is available.
- 9. The purpose of each link is not determined from the link text alone or from the link text together but it displays the file type and the file size. Also, an "External site that opens in a new tab" message appears for external site links.

Despite all the above, we wish to mention that, we are currently in the process of revamping our website to align with the Guidelines for Indian Government Websites (GIGW) 3.0 and other audits.
