

#### Awareness camp on EPIC - Aadhar Card linking

Political Science Programme of DDKSSSBS, Electoral Literacy Club of Goa University, in association with the Chief Electoral Office, Goa, jointly organized an awareness camp on EPIC-Aadhar card linking on Friday, 30th September 2022 in Political Science programme classrooms, Faculty Block-B. The primary objective of the camp was to train the students to link EPIC to their Aadhar card and also create awareness among the young voters on the importance of EPIC-Aadhar card documents and its linkage for transparent electoral processes. The programme started with a welcome address by Dr. Prakash Desai, Programme Director Political Science Programme, followed by an Introduction of the camp by Mr. Ravaji Gaunkar, ELC Nodal Officer and Coordinator of the camp, followed by address of joint CEO Aiesha Vigenkar. She stressed EPIC – Aadhar card linking as necessary steps for a transparent electoral process in India, that everyone should welcome it and take part as responsible citizens of the country. Mr. Sudesh Gaude, CEO Official for Disabled voters, spoke on societal responsibilities toward special needs voters and facilities provided to them by the Election Commission of India.

CEO technical engineer Mr. Pushskar and the team provided physical hands-on training to the participants to link EPIC to Aadhar. Participants actively participated and learned to link their EPIC to Aadhar on their android smart mobile phones. The camp concluded with a formal vote of thanks by Carlos Fernandes, Programme Director of Library Science, Goa University.

The camp was open to all the students, staff, and faculty of Goa University. Around 75 participants attended the awareness camp. Tea and snacks provided to the participants after the camp.
