The team experienced the difficulties faced by the community when there is no accessibility to health, education and to live with limited resources. The team was briefed about the community by Mr. Devidas Gaonkar. The village has total 20 houses and one Government Primary school having one teacher. Team visited the houses in groups to understand their day to day living and interacted with the community. Team visited the Government Primary school and conducted activities for the students and presented gifts for taking part in the activities. There were total 8 students enrolled in this academic year 2023-24 from I to IV standard on the specific day only four students were present. One of the community members Mr. Ram having skill of making Cane Basket (Bethacho Patlo) was requested to demonstrate to students. Also Mr. Yeshwant demonstrated broom weaving and also guided the students to visit the temple on high hill and provided information. Team thanked the community for hosting the students. Students to present their experiences and learnings by presenting and submitting report on 12 October 2023.</p> |
