This campaign employs a threefold strategy. The Narcotics Control Bureau focuses on reducing supply, while the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment handles outreach, awareness, and demand reduction efforts. Meanwhile, the Health Department is responsible for providing treatment.

	<p>This campaign has grown into a nationwide movement, reaching 11 crore people, including 3.5 crore youth and 2.3 crore women. It is expanding its scope through targeted efforts in border areas, spiritual organizations, and educational institutions.</p> <p>June 26th is the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking," with the theme for the year 2024 being 'The evidence is clear: invest in prevention.' To mark this day, Discipline of French and Francophone Studies, Shenoj Goembab School of Languages and Literature administered the NMBA Pledge with Faculty members and Students.</p>
