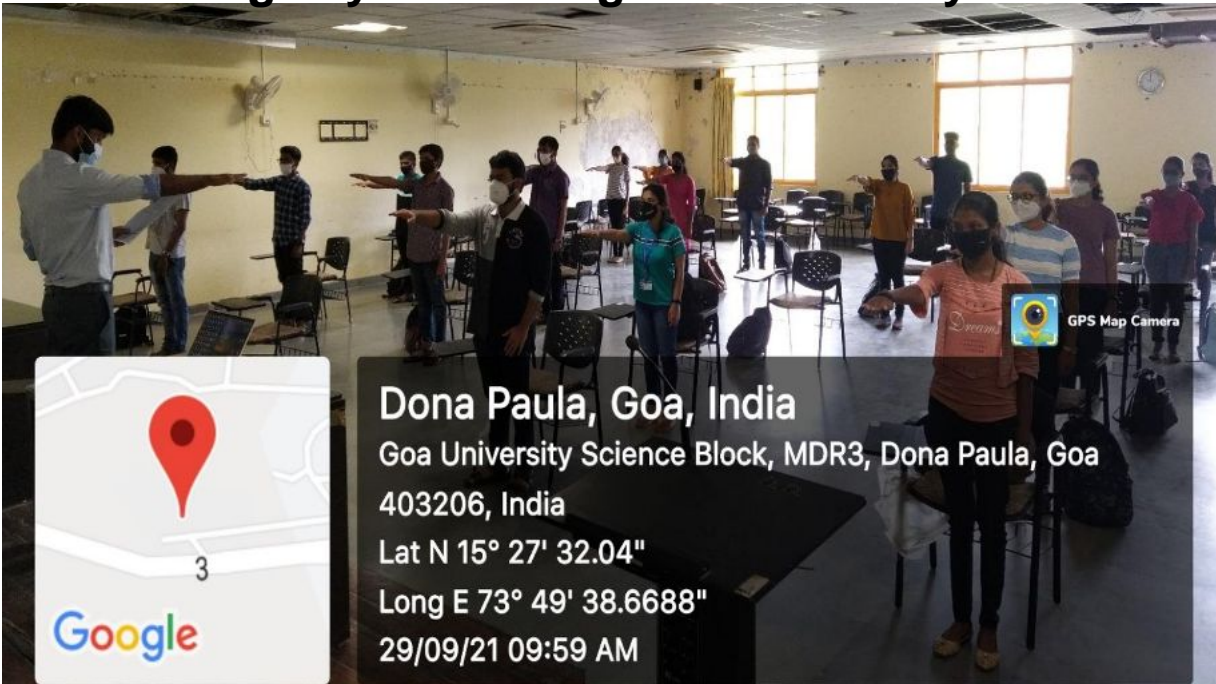


SCS Activities for the Week of Nonviolence from 29th September to 4th October 2021
